

#### **Test**

DOs & DON'Ts

- Naming
  - MyAmazingClassShould
    - beNice\_WhenAskedNicely()

```
class TicTacToeShould {
   @Test
   public void setCurrentPlayerToXInitially () {
```

• Structure: Arrange/Act/Assert

```
public void setCurrentPlayerToXAfterOPlays() {
    TicTacToe board = new TicTacToe();
    board.play(Position.MIDDLE_LEFT);

    board.play(Position.MIDDLE_LEFT);

String player = board.getCurrentPlayer();
    assertEquals( expected: "X", player);
}
```

- Test Behaviour not Implementation
  - One test class -> Multiple production classes



#### **Test**

DOs & DON'Ts

- One test at a time -> test single behaviour
  - multiple 'assert' statements possible

- Use testing framework to avoid repetition
  - QParameterizedTest
  - O @BeforeEach

Test from point of view of API user

## **Implementation**

DOs & DON'Ts

- OK to start with fake implementation
- 'Just enough' to pass a test
- Use IDE
  - Context Actions in IntelliJ
- Green test -> Commit!

### Refactoring

DOs & DON'Ts

- Never with RED tests!
- Use IDE
  - Refactoring or Context Actions in IntelliJ
- Do not start refactoring too early
  - Rule of 3 repetitions
  - 'Right' abstraction
    - IF-condition vs IF-block as a whole
- Guidelines
  - Transformation Priority Premise (TPP)
  - Object Calisthenics
- Run ALL tests and commit if green
